


Where: Design Museum, London When: All through December Defined by an instantly recognisable brand of English eccentricity, the Paul Smith label is one of the bestloved sartorial success stories. This exhibition will recreate his office, providing a key to his eclectic tastes and sources of inspiration. It will also detail his rags to riches career path.



Where: Gallerie Isa, Mumbai When: December 6-January 24 The question of how to represent something dark in the midst of something beautiful has been a constant preoccupation for Martin Eder and a persistent motif in his practice. This comes alive in his first ever solo show in Mumbai. At times he has delved into the territory of the abject in his painting, deliberately interfacing the border between sensual eroticism and unsettling personifications of human desires.
